

DISTRICT III ALL STAR RULES AND REGULATIONS

COACHES:

All Star participants, coaches, date and location should be discussed and decided upon at the All Conference meeting at each level. The All Star consent form should also be passed out to each coach and delivered to the respective participants *prior* to playing in or practicing for the All Star game. There is also a generic congratulatory/informational page that should be passed out as well. All of the above information is available from Mike Fitch, District III All Star Coordinator,

HOSTS:

SANCTIONING: Each All Star game must be SANCTIONED by the Dist. III Coaches Assoc. for liability reasons. *Getting the games sanctioned allows for catastrophic injury insurance and covers all of our bases as far as potential lawsuits.* Do this by contacting Mike Fitch with the Date, Location and Time and he will handle it. GAMES CANNOT OCCUR without proper sanctioning.

SHIRTS: IDAHO SPORTING GOODS has been designated as the provider of the official Dist. III All Star T-Shirts. There is a standard design that will be used at all levels. Each host site will receive shirts: number of shirts is based on number of players and coaches. You can either pick up the t-shirts at Idaho Sporting Goods or they will ship them to you. Contact Tim Brady at ISG to let him know when and where the game will be. ISG is on 10th and State in Boise 344-8448 or 1-800-237-8448. Dist. III Coaches Assoc. will take care of the cost of the shirts with the gate from your respective games.

PLAQUES: A+ Awards in New Plymouth will take care of plaques. You can order 3 plaques for basketball: a boys and girls 3 Point Shot plaque and a Dunk competition plaque. Other sports can be afforded the same number of plaques, just tell A+ Awards what you want them to say. If you are interested in having certificates for your All Stars A+ can provide those as well. A+ will ship them to you. They are very efficient and have the names and addresses of all the schools and the AD's. Dist. III will pay for the cost of the plaques as well.

MISCELANEOUS:

Admission: Every site must charge admission for the game. There is an Expenditures Sheet available from Mike Fitch as well to track the finances of the game. The gate from the game must be turned in to the Dist. III Treasurer Ron Nuxoll at Caldwell High School.

Officials: Each individual site must round up its own officials. If you need assistance with this you can contact Mike Fitch or your respective Officials Commissioner. Officials are usually pretty willing to donate their time for the All Stars.

Practice: Practice must be held before the game. Players must attend the practice in order to participate in the game *unless* they contact a coach, host or Mike Fitch with a valid excuse/conflict in order to miss.

Players: Standard number of players on an seems to be double that are allowed to participate typically (Basketball 10, Soccer 22....). Remember they must be seniors and there should have been a selection process by the league coaches.
